MADHYA PRADESH
ENERGY CONSERVATION AWARD SCHEME

Background

The Govt. of India has enacted Energy Conservation Act- 2001 with the objective to provide a regulatory framework for formulation and implementation of Energy Conservation strategy in the country for efficient use of energy.

Govt. of Energy Department has designated as the Madhya Pradesh Urja Vikas Nigam Ltd. (MPUVNL) as the State Designated Agency (SDA) to coordinate, regulate and enforce the provision of the Energy Conservation Act, 2001 in the State of Madhya Pradesh. In this regard, SDA has identified energy conservation as one of the thrust areas and many initiatives have been taken in this regard. MPUVN Bhopal has prepared an Energy Conservation Action Plan. One of the activity under this plan is to give awards to those consumers of industrial, commercial, govt. buildings, educational institutions, hospitals, municipal committees / corporations and individuals who have excelled in adopting the various energy conservation measures in their buildings / units to save electricity.

Objectives

To give recognition to the industrial units, commercial establishments /organizations and individuals who have made systematic and serious attempts for efficient utilization of energy, conservation of energy, research and promotion of energy efficiency during the year 2018-19 in the State of Madhya Pradesh.

The Awards

The awards are proposed to be given in the form of a Plaque with appropriate citation on such award, as may be decided by the MP Urja Vikas Nigam Ltd./ State Government. The performance would be judged through the pro forma (format enclosed) which would be evaluated by the Award Committee.

It is not necessary to give any or all the awards every year. The Committee would take a final decision depending upon the number of entries received and other considerations. If suitable applicants are not identified to qualify, the award in that category will not be given.

Categories of Awards

The scheme is open to all enterprises in the State of Madhya Pradesh, as per the categorization listed below.

Category 1: Industry

A: Large scale energy consumers

(Including large scale industries –All consumers in the State with a total (electricity + fuel) annual energy consumption more than 1000 TOE (Ton of Oil Equivalent)

B: Medium scale energy consumers

(Including large & medium scale industries – All consumers in the State with a total (electricity + fuel) annual energy consumption between 150 to 1000 TOE)

C: Small scale energy consumers

(Including small scale industries – All consumers in the State with a total (electricity + fuel) annual energy consumption up to 150 TOE)

Category 2: Offices/ Corporate Organizations:

(Including organizations involved in promotional efforts for EC/EE. The scheme is open to all commercial buildings, which are having covered area 500 sq. meter and above or having connected load of 100 kW and above or both.)

Category 3: Government Establishments:

(Including Nagar Nigam, Nagar Palika, Nagar Panchayat etc.)

Category 4:Hotels:

(Including hotels who have implemented energy conservation/ efficiency programs .The scheme is open to all hotels of Madhya Pradesh having connected load 100 kW and above.)

Category 5:Hospitals/ Nursing Homes:

(Including hospitals/ Nursing homes who have implemented energy conservation/ efficiency programs. The scheme is open to all Hospitals/Nursing Homes having connected load 100 kW and above)

Category 6: Educational institutions/ Universities/Schools:

(Educational institutions/ Universities including Engineering Colleges/Schools while highlighting their “research and innovation” may submit the details of tests, testimonials, certifications authenticating their work/ from an approved/accredited institution/lab as applicable.)

Category 7: Energy Efficient Gadgets manufacturer in the state:

Category 8: Special Category/ Individuals -:

(Including Individuals involved in promotional efforts and Innovation in energy conservation/energy efficiency)

Eligibility

- (a) The Scheme is open to all industrial units other than Designated Consumers as notified by BEE and general category is also being included in the award scheme.
- (b) If any unit does not fall under any of the above specified sub-sectors, the unit is encouraged to send nomination under the sub sectors general category.
- (c) The unit should be in production for at least above three years. Important : the annual reports for these years are required to be attached along the Award Questionnaire.
- (d) The unit should be a bona-fide unit and should produce appropriate proof the same from the concerned Govt. agency and that the certificate is valid for the period given above.
- (e) Certificates to the effect that the unit is following all the statutory requirements pertaining to the safety and pollution control should be attached along with the questionnaire.

Criteria for Judging Merit

- (a) The committee will decide the recipient of the award on basis of outstanding achievement and contribution in the field of energy conservation and management.
- (b) The award may not necessary be decided on the basis of only quantitative achievements and other factors such as innovative techniques and technologies adopted, commitment of the management, organizational set-up to promote energy efficiency and energy conservation in the unit, etc. would also be considered.
(A copy of the Criteria for Evaluating the Award Questionnaire/ Application is enclosed at Annexure-1A for reference)
- (c) The members of the Award Committee or their nominees may visit participating units for verification of data supplied, if felt necessary and it will be obligatory on the part of the participating units to provide necessary co-operation to this Committee.

- (d) The Committee will analyze the entries and the decision of the committee would be final and no appeal would be entertained.

Instructions for filling up the ‘award pro forma’

- a) The data required for the questionnaire pertains to the accounting years (2016-2017 and 2017-18).
- b) The enclosed questionnaire is only a format and thus information sought should be separately computer printed or neatly typed or to be downloaded from the MPUVN’s Websites: www.mprenewable.ac.in
- c) The answers to the questions should be precise and specific and should be supplied in total compliance with the questionnaire format. The deviations may lead to improper evaluation or the rejection of the nomination.
- d) The information sought under any head should be highlighted under the same and no separate annexure should be attached.
- e) Each and every query mentioned in the questionnaire needs to be answered. Even, if answer is ‘NO’ or ‘NOT APPLICABLE’ the same may be stated, instead of ignoring it.
- f) The questionnaire should be filled in by a competent and responsible authority of the participating unit. He/ she should be fully conversant with the energy terms and units, conversion / multiplying factors etc. The duly filled-in questionnaire should be signed by the Chief Executive of the company / industrial unit.

Submission of Nomination

One neatly bound copy (preferably spiral bound) of the questionnaire and a soft copy along with participating unit’s annual financial audited reports for the yearsand should reach the office of:
