

MP ENERGY CONSERVATION AWARD

(Award for excellence in energy conservation and management)

INTRODUCTION

The increasing preference for commercial energy has led to a sharp increase in the demand for electricity and fossil fuels resulting in emission of huge quantity of carbon dioxide causing serious environmental damages. There is still considerable potential for reducing energy consumption by adopting energy efficiency measure at various sectors of economy. Energy efficiency will not only reduce the need to create new capacity requiring high investment, but also result in substantial environmental benefits.

The state Government in consultation with “BEE” designated MP Urja Vikas nigam as State Designated Agency (SDA) for enforcing The Energy Conservation ACT (EC Act) 2001 in the state, within the overall frame work of the ACT with the primary objective of reducing energy intensity of the Indian economy. This will be achieved with active participation of all stakeholders, resulting in accelerated and sustained adoption of energy efficiency in all sectors.

In one of the many initiatives; state Government is launching a scheme to encourage, motive as well as given recognition through “**M.P. Energy Conservation Awards**” to industrial units, Commercial establishments and Government sector; who have taken extra efforts to reduce energy intensities while maintaining the production levels. The scheme is aimed to create an environment that would spur industries in achieving excellence in efficient use of energy and its conservation.

OBJECTIVE

To giving the recognition to the industrial units/commercial establishment & professionals working in the field of energy management; and to have made systematic and serious attempts for efficient utilization and conservation of energy during of the year.

THE AWARD

Different category of award for the best (First), second, third and consolation are proposed to be given in each Sector / sub-sectors in the form of a plaque with appropriate citation on such awards as may be decided by the URJA

VIKAS NIGAM / State Government The performance of units would be judged through the questionnaire (format enclosed), which would be evaluated by an Award Committee.

It is not necessary to give any or all awards every year. Award Committee would take a final decision on the number of awards, depending on the number and quality of entries received. If suitable applicants are not identified to qualify, the award in that category will not be given.

ELIGIBILITY

- (a) The Scheme is open to all categories included in the award scheme except DC's (Designated Consumers) notified by Bureau of Energy Efficiency.
- (b) If any unit does not fall under any of the specified sub-sectors, the unit is encouraged to send nomination under the sub sectors general category.
- (c) The unit should be a bona-fide unit and should produce appropriate proof the same from the concerned Govt. agency and that the certificate is valid for the period given above.
- (d) The unit should be in production for at least last three years. (Important: the annual reports for these years are required to be attached along the Award Questionnaire.)
- (e) Certificates to the effect that the unit is following all the statutory requirements pertaining to the safety and pollution control should be attached along with the questionnaire.
- (f) A certificate of certified energy Auditor is mandatory for certifying the energy savings.

Criteria for judging Merit

- (a) Evaluation of the nominations will be done based on the evaluation & weight-age criteria.
- (b) Evaluation will be made on the basis of the information and savings made along with the projects implemented, as required in Questionnaires.
- (c) The Award Committee will decide the recipient of the awards on the basis of the outstanding achievements and contribution in the field of energy efficiency, conservation and management (subject to minimum of 3 units).
- (d) The award committee will analyze the entries and the decision of the committee would be final.
- (e) The Award may not necessarily be decided on the basis of quantitative achievements, but other factors such as innovative techniques and technologies adopted, commitment of the management, organizational set-up to promote energy efficiency and energy conservation in the unit, etc. would also be considered.
- (f) The members of the Award Committee or their nominees may visit participating units for verification of data supplied, if felt necessary and it will be

obligatory on the part of the participating units to provide necessary co-operation to this committee.

- (g) The committee may invite some of the selected units for presentation before finalizing the list of Award winning units. The units have to bear all the expenditure in this connection.
- (h) The Committee's decision would be final and no appeal would be entertained.

Instruction for filling up to the 'Award Questionnaire'

- (a) The data required for the questionnaire pertains to the accounting years.
- (b) The enclosed questionnaire is only a format and thus information sought should be separately attached, duly computer printed or neatly typed and duly signed by authorized signatory.
- (c) The answer to the question should be precise and specific and should be supplied in total compliance with the questionnaire format the deviation may lead to improper evaluation or rejection of the nomination.
- (d) The information sought under any head should be highlighted under the same and no separate annexure should be attached.
- (e) Each and every query mentioned in the questionnaire needs to be answered Even, if answer in "No" or "Not Applicable" The same may be stated, instead of ignoring it.
- (f) The questionnaire should be filled in by a competent and responsible person of the company. He/she be fully conversant with the energy terms and units, conversion factors etc. The duly filled-in questionnaire should be signed by the Chief Executive of the company.

One neat copy of the questionnaire (including relevant certificate and papers) along with company's annual audited report for three previous should reach the office of:-
